

Project -2 Water Reticulation Construction

Under Restart NSW Water Security for Regions Programme, Council recently constructed a new Potable Water Reticulation System at Rankins Springs at a cost of approximately \$400,000.

The potable water main was constructed to supply potable water from the newly constructed Water Treatment Plant via a separate line to avoid cross-contamination and to protect public health.

Approximately 5,000 metres of potable water mains were laid using the method of trenching and under boring.

Currently, a new connection is available at each property, with further work required by the property owner to connect the new supply to their houses.

Council is also offering a subsidy with the aim to provide assistance to the property owner for connection to the potable water.
