The Carrathool Bridge

The Carrathool Bridge is one of the last lifting bridges remaining in Australia. The heritage-listed bridge was built in 1922 and the lift span last opened for river traffic in the 1930s. To see the bridge, which is 5km out of town, head along Hillston Street towards the Murrumbidgee River. Turn right at the T-intersection, drive approximately 500 metres and then turn left towards the Sturt Highway (signposted to Hay and Narrandera).
